

Making Mother's Day Egg Box Flowers

Consider the safety of using any small parts or items with very young children and choose appropriately:

You will need:

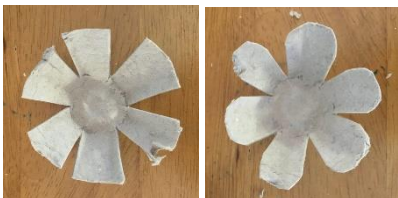
- Egg boxes
- Paints and brushes
- Scissors
- Lolly pop sticks
- Glue
- String
- Card or paper for label
- Buttons and glitter optional
- Small jar or pot optional

What to do:

1. Cut your egg box so that you have the individual pieces.



2. Make cuts, between 3 and 6 (depending how many petals you want), down to the base to start creating the petals. Spread the petals out a little and then you can round off the petals if you want or make different shape petals.



3. Paint your flower and lolly stick with paints and let them dry.



4. Cut leaves from card or if you have green egg boxes – from the top flat half of the egg box. Stick your leaves to the top of the lolly sticks and then your flower on top of those. You could add glitter or buttons to the centre of the flower if you like.



5. If you want to include a message you could attach a label to the flower.



6. You could carry on a create a small bunch of flowers with different messages or words you want to say to your mum or that remind you of her, and collect them all in a jar, small pot or attach them to a canvas.
